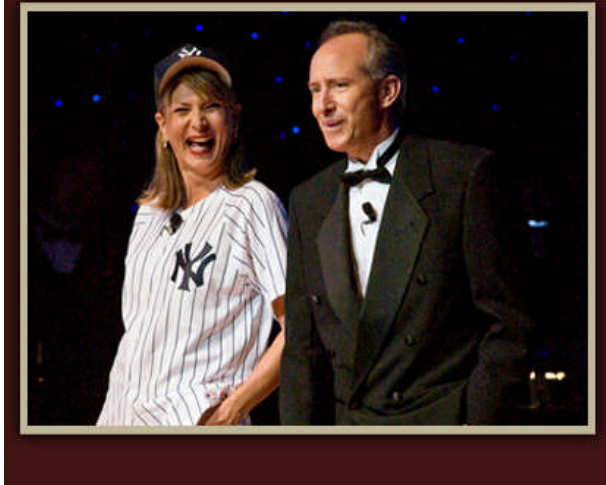




Thanks for the Memories-a USO Style Tribute to Bob Hope! May 28 - 30, 2010
